

## Timeline and Checklist

Please note that we will send a more detailed timeline with specific dates closer to your start date, should you decide to pay a deposit.

	Attend an event/visit campus.
	• We host several events throughout the year. Refer to your Admitted Students Events
	handout or check the website for more details!
	Pay your deposit.
	<ul> <li>Refer to your decision letter for deadlines and processes.</li> </ul>
	Set up your Bear ID and your email, and log into BearWeb.
	• You will receive information about these topics within two weeks of submitting your seat deposit.
	File the FAFSA and send it to Baylor.
	• You may file as early as October 1 for the next academic year, which begins in August. The preferred deadline is February 1, but the final deadline is a month before classes
	begin. Please refer to your financial aid step-by-step for more information specific to differing entering classes.
	Receive your financial aid package from the Baylor University Student Financial Aid
	Office.
	• You will receive your financial aid package after paying your seat deposit/after the
	Student Financial Aid Office has begun packing for your term. Refer to your financial
	aid step-by-step for more details.
	Apply for and receive additional loans.
	• You may apply beginning 90 days before you start classes. Try to apply no later than a
	month before you start classes.
	Complete steps in registration email.
	• Register for classes.
	• Send health forms.
	• Send matriculation forms.
	<ul> <li>You will receive an email with documents and instructions approximately six</li> </ul>
	weeks before classes begin.
	Receive your bill.
	• Your bill will be emailed to you at the beginning of the month after you register.
	Make sure your bill is balanced.

The balance on your bill will be due at the end of the month after you register.

	<ul> <li>Get a locker, student ID, and parking pass.</li> <li>You will receive more information about lockers, student IDs, and parking permits as</li> </ul>
	your entering quarter approaches.
	Receive your book list and purchase books.
	• You will be able to access your book list approximately two weeks before classes begin.
	You may purchase books online or at the Baylor Bookstore. Please note that you will
	need hard copies of your books, as most first-year professors do not allow you to use
	laptops in class.
	Receive refund.
	• Assuming you have applied for aid in a timeline manner, if you set up direct deposit
	through the Baylor E-bill system, you will be able to receive excess financial aid five
	days before classes begin.
	Attend Orientation.

• Mandatory Orientation is the Wednesday and Thursday before classes begin.
